Guidelines for Special Session Proposers

This document reports the information needed to prospective Special Session organizers to submit their Special session proposals at IEEE I2MTC 2018.

We want to make IEEE I2MTC 2018 an attractive venue, particularly for special sessions. Therefore, we want to involve Special Session organizers not only through the proposal of their own topic through a Special Session but also to give a “character” to their Session through the possibility of an opening oral presentation, a “position paper”, where main features, novelties, significance and state of the art of the Special Session topic can be presented.

We are therefore soliciting the Special Session organizers to identify proper authors and to propose, together with their Special Session, a position paper. This paper will be reviewed and, if accepted, it will be scheduled as the session’s opening paper with a double time slot if necessary (this has to be discussed with Technical Program Chairs).

The full version of the position paper has to be submitted as soon as it is ready after the approval of the Special Session proposal (in any case not later than the regular full paper submission deadline).

Immediately after the outcome of the review process, if the position paper is accepted, it will be shown in the Special Sessions page of the conference website.

If the Special Session is approved the organizers are expected to attend the conference and to chair the oral sessions where the Special Session papers will be presented.

In the following the information to be provided by Special Session proposers can be found. This information has to be sent within a single .pdf file to one of the Special session co-chairs listed below.
